10th International Conference on Russian Studies in History in Budapest **"Russian Studies in History in the 21st Century"** May 18-19, 2015.

The Centre for Russian Studies at the Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest, seeks proposals from scholars of all levels for papers that explore any aspect of Russian Studies in History which mark out new perspectives in Russian Studies in History either by their topic or their approach. Working languages are Russian and English.

In May 2015 the Centre for Russian Studies in Budapest celebrates its 20th anniversary and its 25th anniversary if taking into consideration the foundation of its predecessor the Hungarian Institute for Russian Studies. For this honorable occasion, we are announcing our 10th biennale international academic conference. The aim of the conference is to provide an opportunity for dialogue between well-known and young researchers from different countries and cultures to discuss newly emerging academic questions and approaches in the field of Russian History.

The panels will be organized based on the topics of the accepted abstracts.

Selected papers will be published in a conference volume by the end of 2015.

If you would like to present at the conference, please submit the attached survey by November 17, 2014.

Deadline for submitting abstracts: February 15, 2015. (Length: 2000 characters, including spaces).

Authors will be notified about the acceptance or rejection of their abstracts by March 15, 2015.

Deadline for paying the conference fee: March 30, 2015.

The **completed essays** in English or Russian (length: 15.000–20.000 characters, including spaces) must be sent by May 15, 2015. Presentations will be limited to 20 minutes in length.
